<sup>1</sup>RI: Mandated length of quarantine/isolation around importation is dependent on the class of license a rescue possesses. (SOS is Class A in RI) Class A: 14-day quarantine/isolation <u>before</u> import/transport.

Class B: 5-day quarantine/isolation after import/transport.

All dogs not quarantined/isolated for 14 days prior to import, or that were on non-USDA import will be quarantined/isolated for 5 days, per RI regulations. <sup>2</sup> ME requires the additional vaccination of leptospirosis for dogs imported into the state.
